



AUDITION SIDES: Each auditioner must choose ONE of the following sides to perform SOLO at audition. Memorization of your choice is preferred but not required. Ability to best demonstrate your chosen character with appropriate voice and expression, proper posture and body movements determine casting. Director may request you perform another side in addition to your selection. All casting comes from these sides.

People say that pinks for girls and not for guy, but pink's the coolest color to my eyes. It takes a strong boy to love the color pink to stand up to what all the people think. I got the pink blues in every fuchsia hue, what am I gonna do?

MRS. PINKERTON/DR. WINK: Her school picture is coming up! I just got her a new orange dress and it is going to clash with her pink complexion. I can't believe this is happening, after all the healthy food that I have fed my children, after all the money I have spent at the organic food co-op!

MR. PINKERTON: Remember how Dr. Wink said there was one other case of pinkitis? Well, I was THE person who had pinkitis. I admit it, ok? It was me. I used to love the color pink and one day when I was a boy I ate one too many pink lollipops. I turned pink from my toenails to my hair follicles. Do you know what that is like for a boy? It was so embarrassing. All the children teased me in school. Don't you see? I just want to protect my children. I don't want Pinkalicious to go through what I went through. I don't want Peter to have to deal with that either. I thought if I didn't allow him to play with pink toys, perhaps he might stop liking the color pink.
